SCHOOL COUNCIL

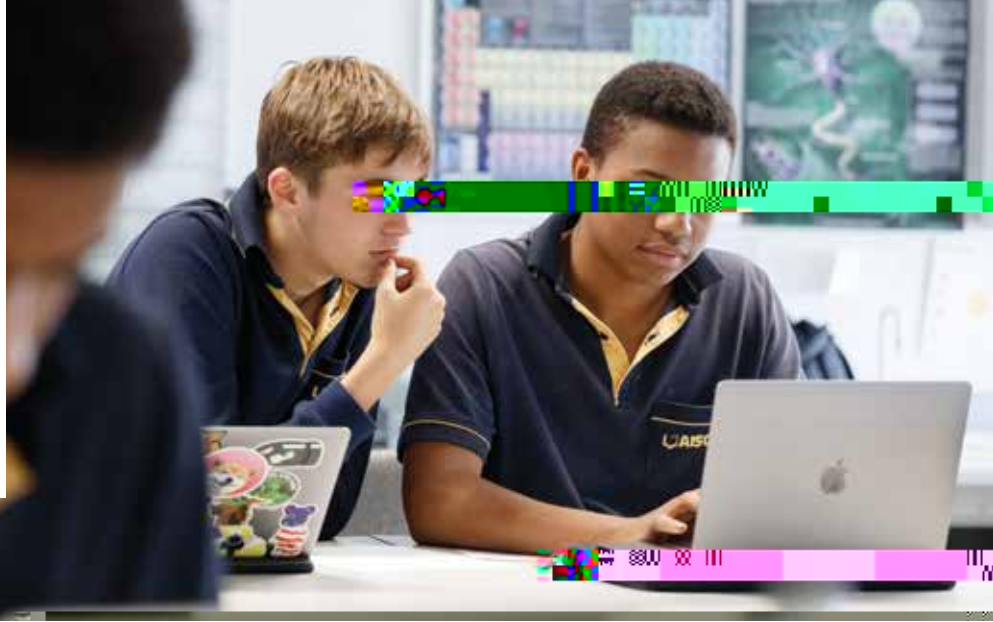

STANDARDIZED TESTING

External standardized assessments are an important source of information. AISCT utilizes a number of external assessment service providers to ensure our program continues to meet exceptional international standards.



GRADES 2–8

6 WXGHQWV LQ *UDGHV WDNH WKH 1 RUWKZHVW (YDOXDWLRQ Association's (NWEA) Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment, which is based in the USA. The MAP LV WDNHQ DW WKH EHJLQQLQJ DQG HQG RI the year and focuses on growth during the course of the year. Students, teachers, and parents are able to see the growth made in reading, language arts, and math. The MAP is the most widely used standardized assessment in international schools.

GRADES 9–11

6 WXGHQWV LQ *UDGHV WDNH WKH 3 UHOLHUHOHFWLYH (PSAT) Aptitude Test (PSAT). This assessment is designed to prepare students for university admissions tests, including the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT).

GRADES 11–12
